2018 Fee Adjustment

With effect from 1 July 2018, the maximum Service Fee for Participating Service Provider (PSP) had been adjusted from \$3,155 to \$3,283 (↑4.1%) per patient per year according to the change in Composite Consumer Price Index (Medical Services) during July 2017 to June 2018.

Now **\$283.5**/consultation and **\$112** for drugs/Quarter

$$\$283.5 \times 10 + \$112 \times 4 = \text{up to } \$3,283 / \text{Patient/ Year}$$

New Request Form of Unlocking Consultation

The Request Form for Unlocking and Inputting Consultation Record has been revised to allow greater flexibility. You may download the new form at the eHRSS portal landing page (under “**User Documents**” > “**Manual & User Guide**”)



- ✓ For inputting a missing consultation record, prior creation of a record in the GOPC PPP Profile before submitting an unlock request is no longer required. Please submit an unlock request directly.
- ✓ For editing of consultation date or input of missing consultation, please provide clinic record as supporting document. The patient will receive notification of such change.
- ✓ Upon approval of your request, you will be notified by email, and the time period for editing has been extended to 7 calendar days.



Vigilance of Dengue Fever

In response to the latest situation of local outbreak of dengue fever (DF), the government is taking multiple measures on preventing widespread in Hong Kong. Community efforts would be essential in combating mosquitoes and your assistance is requested to enhance surveillance for suspected DF cases.

- ◆ Arrange blood test for patients with symptoms compatible with DF
- ◆ Report to the Central Notification Office (CENO) of the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) if the preliminary blood test result is positive
- ◆ Refer DF patients with fever to hospital for further management
- ◆ Advise patients to take protective measures against mosquito bites
