New Smart Identity Card

Dear Doctors,

To tie in with the commencement of the territory-wide identity card replacement exercise, the Smart Identity Card Electronic Authentication System (IDEAS) of Electronic Health Record Sharing System (eHRSS) will be updated to accommodate the use of new smart HKICs starting from 1 March 2019 (Friday). The existing eHRSS card readers can still be used for both existing and new smart HKICs. You only need to insert patient's smart HKIC to the card reader with the chip facing upward, and then select the version of the smart HKIC to proceed.

For more information, you may refer to the quick guide appended for detailed instruction.

Smart HKIC will also be used for taking attendance record in GOPC PPP later this year, aiming to enhance record accuracy of your reimbursement claim by confirming patient attendance on the date of consultation. Further details would be announced in due course.
