### **New Co-payment Arrangements for Haemodialysis Public-Private Partnership Programme**

As announced earlier on 25 March 2025, the Hospital Authority (HA) will implement the Public Healthcare Fees and Charges Reform starting 1 January 2026.

Under the Terms and Conditions of the Haemodialysis Public-Private Partnership Programme (HD PPP), all existing patients, together with newly participating patients, are required to pay co-payment amounts equivalent to the HA fees and charges as set out in the Gazette to receive services.

The following co-payment will take effect from 1 January 2026:

<b>Service</b>	<b>Gazette Fee</b>
Day Procedure (Renal Clinic)	\$250 per attendance

In addition to the existing medical fee waiving mechanism, the HA establishes a second safety net by introducing a HK\$10,000 cap on an eligible patient's annual spending for specified public medical fees and charges without requiring financial assessment with effect from 1 January 2026. The fees and charges payable by the patient being an Eligible Person to private practitioners under this programme will be counted towards the eligible medical fees and charges of the Annual Spending Cap. The spending amount can be checked via HA Go, One-Stop Electronic Kiosk and any hospital's Shroff office. Patients should refer to the Guide on Annual Spending Cap for details.

The existing waiver arrangement will remain unchanged after the implementation of the Public Healthcare Fees and Charges Reform.

The HA will update relevant payment arrangement to ensure that correct co-payment amount is collected by community haemodialysis centres.
